Knuckle Dusters are making their move in the Doomsday division?



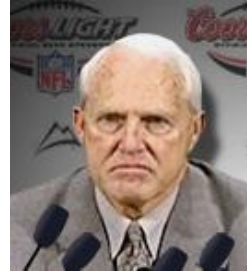
Walsh: Without a doubt. The way they approach each game really impresses me.

TBB: Are the Widowmakers the villain of the league?



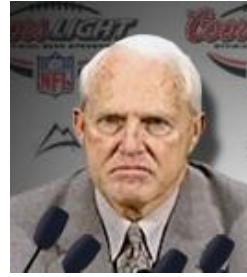
Walsh: Absolutely! They make it look easy don't they? But, it takes a lot of practice.
