

Gentlemen,

Some *huge* matchups this weekend. With only two weeks to go, here is how it breaks down...

From the Playoff Rules (<http://www.afsn.net/football/2006/sffl/rules-playoffs.htm>):

In the event that two or more teams have identical won-loss records at the conclusion of the season, **and have played the same number of Head-to-Head games between them** (*which will always be true of teams in the same division*), the following tie-breaking system is employed:

- 1 - Overall record
- 2 - Head-to-head record
- 3 - Overall points
- 4 - Head-to-head points
- 5 - Division record

P-cubed 8-4 at Bear Necessities 7-5

If Brad wins this week, he'll be two games up on Butch with only one week to go -- he'd win the division and Butch would be out of the playoffs seeing that his Breakdown record isn't good enough to win the Wild Card.

Butch has already beaten Brad once. If he beats him again, they'll be tied at 8-5 and Butch will hold the tie-breaker advantage based on head-to-head record. If Butch turns around and beats Greg the following week, it won't matter what Brad does, Butch will win the division. If Butch were to lose to Greg the following week, and Brad were to beat Dave... a mess of possibilities... we'd just have to wait it out and see what happens.

It's going to take both remaining weeks to decide the TA&T division. Whoever wins this week is in control and can guarantee a division championship by winning the following week too.
