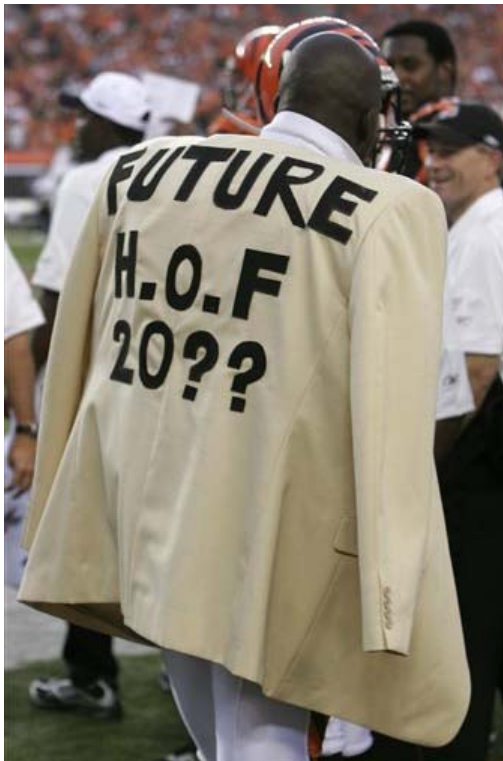
## Free Agency and the big Oh
